Instructions:

- 1. Read this passage again
- 2. Note all the times that someone or a group of people approach Jesus or ask Him for something.
- 3. Note all the times that Jesus acts or says something that doesn't fit what you'd expect from the typical person in authority.
- 4. Reflect on the following questions:
- Who are the people that approach Jesus? What do they have in common? What is different about them? What does this tell you about Jesus?

• Jesus clearly isn't what people expected as a Savior. How has He defied your expectations or previous understandings of who He is at different times in your life?

• Humility certainly is a point of emphasis for Jesus in how He interacts with others and the posture He expects His followers to embrace. In what ways do you struggle to embrace the posture of humility in your relationships? How can you submit that struggle to the Spirit to grow your character?
